[Zaha Hadid Architects](#) has collaborated with Neutra and Citco on two new furniture series presented at the recent [Salone del Mobile](#) in Milan.

With [Neutra](#), the firm unveiled The Erosion Collection, inspired by geology and sculptural form, while with [Citco](#), ZHA unveiled The Aeris Collection, exploring structural engineering principles.

First introduced in 2024 with the marble MINERA Table and BRANCH Console, The Erosion Collection draws on natural erosion processes to create fluid, carved forms that emphasize the material qualities of stone. The latest additions include a bench, coffee table, low chair, low table, carpet, and tableware.

While earlier pieces focused on the density and permanence of marble, the expanded [furniture](#) collection incorporates lighter materials such as carbon fiber, leather, and textiles, introducing greater softness and flexibility. Across the series, the relationship between furniture, sculpture, and landscape is explored through the use of layered forms and contrasting material properties.
